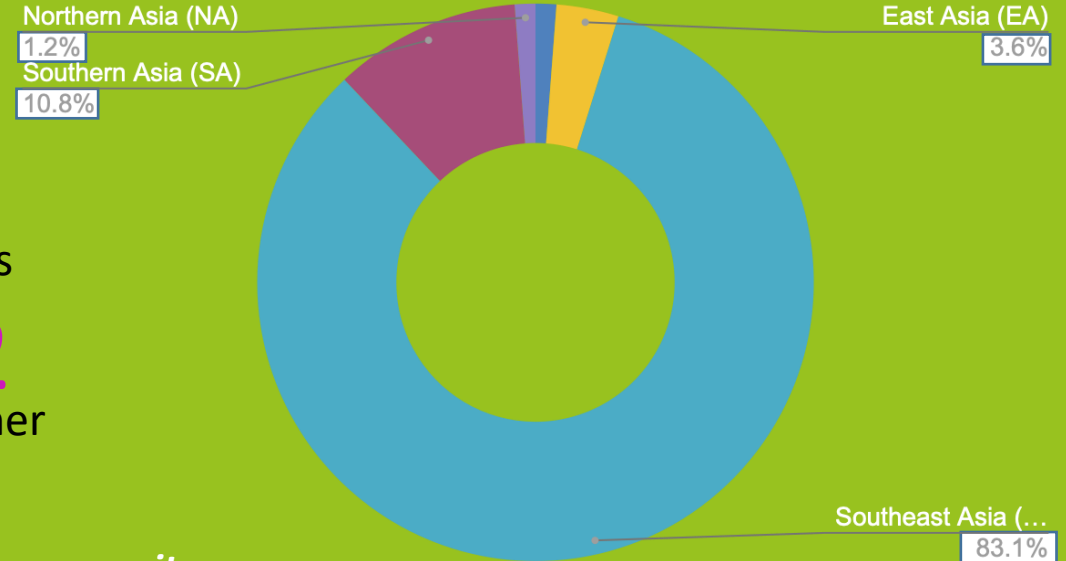

Internet governance & community

Participants

- **>60% selected participants attended** the 4-day camp
(135 selected from 19 economies)
- Overall Attendance rate: **>78%**
- Highest Attendance: **>90%** on Day 0
(Based on 83 youth participants)

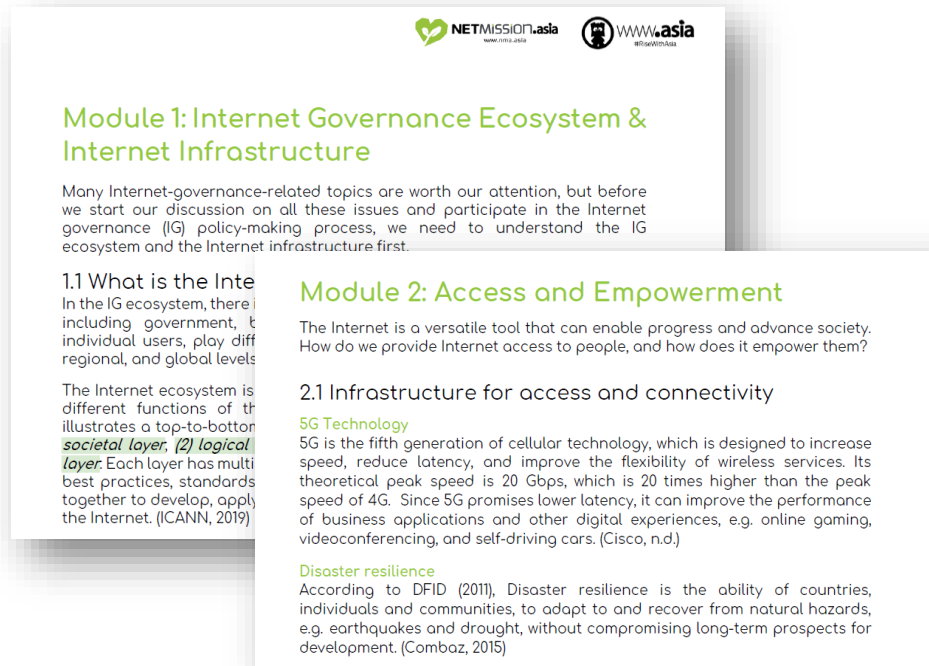
